Commitment & Preferred Requirements:

- 6. Past board or committee experience is an asset.

Directors of the Board are not remunerated. BC Rugby covers the cost of travel to attend inperson board meetings and key events with the Directors' presence is requested. BC Rugby allocates budget to support the Directors of the Board's professional development to best serve their collective responsibilities to the organization. Board member terms are two-years, while committee appointments are done annually.
