COACH REQUIREMENTS

The candidates for these positions should hold the following accreditation:

- Currently Registered with BC Rugby
- Completed Police Record Check required for all Coaches working with Youth
- Completed Rugby Ready and World Rugby Concussion Module
- Level 2 Trained and or L2 certified Rugby Coach (will need to be certified ahead of CS Games)
- A minimum of two years coaching experience in the specific coaching context at the Club/School/University and Regional Levels

Exemplary communication and interpersonal skills are critical for success in this role involving interaction with players, other zone coaches and managers, BCRU staff, volunteers, and the general public. Team building and conflict resolution skills are essential.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Coach's duties involve:

- Setting selection camps that are regionally specific and allow for equal representation from the whole zone
- Working with the Provincial Head Coach & Technical Director to make sure all staff and players meet the minimum requirements to attend the event
- Plan and implement regional team player selections, practices, development camps and preparation for games and competitions that align with the provincial pathway
- Effective co-ordination and communication of game preparation and implementation
- Knowledge and understanding of game adjustments and facilitating them during competition
- Co-ordination of post-game analysis of statistics and video (if possible) and the implementation of adjustments to practice and game plan preparation
- Work collaboratively with the Technical Director/Provincial Head Coach to develop, refine and execute a team plan that maximizes player development
- Communicate areas of responsibility for team captain and other team leaders
