Job Description

Coaching collective:

- Attend the majority of training sessions (Tuesday and Thursday evenings) and Saturday games from Mid August 2024 until May 2025
- Develop a competitive training program based on team goals and game play
- Player engagement and development through meetings and goal setting sessions
- Be familiar with and advocate for United's inclusive values and the laws of the game including fair play

Eligibility:

- Experience with adult 15's rugby rules and game play
- Completion of the following coaching certifications (prior to season start)
 - Rugby Ready
 - Concussion management
 - Player welfare
- Advanced coaching qualifications are considered an asset but are not necessary to apply
- Must be a Canadian Citizen or already be eligible to work in Canada. **United Rugby is unable to sponsor out of the country**
