Rules of Competition

This event is governed by the <u>BC Rugby Age-Grade Rules of Competition</u>.

Game-On variations are eligible to be applied for all playoff games.

Jersey Colour

Some divisions may require communications between teams to avoid colour clashes. Mainland teams will be viewed as the 'away' team and therefore have first choice on jersey colour.

Key Deadlines & Timelines

• **9am Friday Dec 6th** - Team Rosters for Playoffs must be submitted to BC Rugby via Sportlomo. All rosters submitted will be checked to ensure Rules compliance.

Law Variations

<u>Rugby Canada's Age-Grade Law Variations</u> will be used for this event. Format may change if teams are unable to have a full roster.





Medical Information

BC Rugby Medical Staff will be present during the event. Therapists will be wearing Red Pinnies to identify themselves.

Players may receive assessments or injury management from the Medical Staff at the tent at any time. No taping will take place.

BC Rugby's number one priority is player safety and adheres to World Rugby's policy of 'Recognize and Remove' when dealing with concussions or suspected concussions.

Any player suspected or suffering from concussion should be immediately removed from competition and report to BC Rugby Medical Staff for evaluation. Not reporting injury symptoms to avoid medical evaluation significantly increases the risk prolonging recovery and long-term effects.

Alternatively, players can be directed to Urgent Care at Westshore Urgent Primary Care Centre for evaluation and treatment from a physician for any injury. Please provide documentation to the medical tent for completion of the incident and witness report forms.

Coaches & Manager Certification

Teams should be aware that all Coaches and Managers are required to have completed the following online courses:

- World Rugby Concussion Management for the General Public
- World Rugby Rugby Ready Course

All coaches and managers must be registered in Sportlomo under the relevant categories and associated with the club they are coaching.

Weather Advisory and Cancellation Protocol

Rain and snow can be forecast leading up to and including the Age-Grade Finals Day, BC Rugby will monitor the situation accordingly. Safety is always the primary concern, and we might be forced to make a tough decision at late notice.

In the event of cancellation due to inclement weather or any other unforeseen event, champions may not be able to be determined. This is unless teams agree to rearrange





and play out the championship fixture at another venue within 10 days of the original date, in which case BC Rugby will honor the result of the replayed match.
